Pupil Premium Spending 2015/16

The school expects to receive £13,040 in Pupil Premium. The planned spend for this money is identified below. The intention is to improve attainment levels and progress rates of the targeted group. Budget year ends April 2016.

Teaching and Training: £9,277 to provide Teaching Assistant funding for directed learning; support 1to1 / group tuition work; facilitate pupil mentoring; phonics training.

Curriculum Resources and Assessment: £2,373 Materials and subscriptions to support spelling, handwriting, maths and grammar. Assessment materials to establish start of year and periodic attainment and progress.

Enrichment Activities and subsidies: £1390 Workshops, music tuition, club, uniform, milk and visit subsidies.

The anticipated outcome of this year's Pupil Premium contributions are:

- Targeted writing and maths support for Years 1,2,3,4,5,6.
- Improved tracking and progress of targeted pupils
- Progress of targeted pupils to meet or exceed expected outcomes in reading, writing and maths in order to reduce gaps in attainment; including phonics, handwriting, grammar and spelling.
- Increase in enrichment opportunities and wellbeing
